The smallest dose of unheated, defatted cow's milk given in our study protocol [5] was 15mg. This means the last three columns in HSS [2] were not used for severity scoring in our study. The severity score of a reaction with HSS [2] was based both on the symptoms and the cumulative eliciting dose. Scores 1-5 were considered mild, scores 6-13 as moderate and scores 14-25 as severe. Only the most severe symptom resulting in the highest score was used for scoring.

The smallest dose of unheated, defatted cow's milk given in our study protocol [5] was 15mg. Thus, the last column in mHSS [7] was not used for severity scoring in our study. Scores 1-5 were considered mild, scores 6-13 as moderate and scores 14-25 as severe. Only the most severe symptom resulting in the highest score was used for scoring.

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## Modifications mHSS [7] made to HSS [2]:

- Localized urticaria was defined as <5 lesions on face/extremities or pruritus
  - o HSS [2] did not define what was considered as localized urticaria
- Abdominal pain was further divided into mild and moderate
  - o HSS [2] only had one category for abdominal pain
- Severity of generalized urticaria was emphasized as generalized urticaria was considered moderate at all cumulative doses
  - o In HSS [2] severity of generalized urticaria depended on the cumulative eliciting dose (mild if >100mg, otherwise moderate)
- Lethargy and diarrhea were added as recognized symptoms in the same category with vomiting
- Respiratory symptoms were described in more detail: hoarseness of voice, stridor, cough, mild wheezing, pain in the throat, which better standardizes their assessment between clinicians
  - o Originally described in HSS [2] as laryngeal edema/mild wheezing
  - o mHSS [7] did not differentiate persistent cough from non-persistent cough
- Severe respiratory symptoms and collapse were defined in more detail: pallor, drop in arterial blood saturation <92%, severe bronchial obstruction, drop in blood pressure
  - o Originally described in HSS [2] as collapse or severe respiratory symptoms
- Upper respiratory symptoms remained unrecognized also in mHSS [7]

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
